Through the lenses of a keen observer of world affairs, Prof. Raboy will provide a lively account of Marconi's story, from young inventor, to start up entrepreneur, Nobel laureate and global businessman among the world leaders of his time. Prof. Raboy's book is based on original research and unpublished archival materials in four countries and several languages and it was among the five finalists of this year's prestigious Charles Taylor Prize for non fiction. The lecture will be followed by a brief Q&A session, book signing (20% discount on the book) and a light reception.
